The people of Christchurch are at the heart of this infrastructure rebuild. The Stronger Christchurch Infrastructure Rebuild Team (SCIRT) is committed to keeping people well informed about the work we are doing.

During the infrastructure rebuild, SCIRT will be asking the people of Christchurch how satisfied they are with how we are communicating. One way we will do this is using independent market researchers.

Researchers will door-knock residents in areas where works are underway. The surveys only take about seven to eight minutes to complete.

SCIRT is using researchers from **Research First**. All market researchers will have identification. We encourage residents to ask to see this identification to ensure the researchers are bona fide.
